A PROCLAMATION.



HEREAS the Indians of Norridgework, Arrelagun a wek, Wewsensch and St. Juhn's Tribes, and the Indians of the other Tribes inhabiting in the Eaftern and Northern Parts of His Majefly's Teritories of New-England, the Penshlost Tribe only excepted, have, contrary to their folemn Submittion unto His Majefly long fince made and frequently renewed, been guilty of the moft perfolicos, barbarous and inhuman Murders of divers of ha Majefly's Englift Subjects; and have abstained from all Commerce and Correspondence with His Majefly's

faid Subjects for many Months part ; and the faid Indians have fully diffeovered an inimical, traiterious and rebellious Intention and Difposition ;

Dabe therefore thought fit to illue this proclamation, and to Derlare the Indians of the Norridgework, Arrefaguatacook, Weweenock and & John's Erthes, and the Indians of the other Erths and enlate inhabiting in the Caffern and Borthern Parts of Dis Opaicfly's Certifories of New-England, and in Alliance and Confederace with the above-retited Erthes, the Penobleon only ercepted, to be erremits, Stokels and Eraitors to bis Opaicfly: And I to hereby require his Opaicfly's .utjeds of this Brobince to embrace all Opportunities of purfuing, captibating, killing and befreying all and any of the aforefast Jahans, the Penobleon creepito.

AND WHEREAS the General Court of this Province have voted. That a Bounty or Encouragement be granted and allowed to be paid out of the Publick-Treasury to the matching Army that shall be employed for the Defence of the Eastern and Western Frontiers from the Twenty-fifth of this Month of Juni until the Twenty-fifth of November next;

T have thought fit to public the fame : and I bo hereby promife. That there shall be paid out of the produce. Treafary to all and any of the faid forces, over and above their Bounty upon Enlishment, where Ellages and buildingers, the Prenumms or Bounties following, viz.

For every Male Indian Priforer above the Age of Twelve Years, that thall be taken and brought to Beflon, Fifty Pounds.

For every Male Indian Scalp, brought in as Evidence of their being killed, Forty Pounds.

For every Female Indian Prifoner, taken and brought in as aforefaid, and for every Male Indian Prifoner under the Age of Twelve Years, taken and brought in as aforefaid, Twenty-for Pounds.

For every Scalp of fuch Female Indian or Male Indian under Twelve Years of Age, brought as Evidence of their being killed, as aforefaid, Twenty Poundr.

G IVE N under my Hand at Bolton, in the Province aforefuld, this Twelfth Dey of June, 1755, and in the Twenty-eighth Year of the Reign of and Severeign Lord GEORGE the Second, by the Grace of GOD, of Great-Britain, France, and Iceland, KING, Defender of the Faith, Soc.

A P R O C L A M A T I O N

WHEREAS the Tribe of *Penobscot* Indians have repeatedly in a perfidious Manner acted contrary to their solemn Submission unto His Majesty long since made and frequently renewed;

have therefore, at the desire of the house of representatives, with the advice of his Majesty's

Council, thought fit to issue this proclamation, and to declare the Penobscot Tribe of Indians to be Enemies, Rebels and Traitors to his Majesty King George the Second: And I do hereby require his Majesty's Subjects of this province to embrace all Opportunities of pursuing, captivating, killing and destroying all and every of the aforesaid Indians.

AND WHERE AS the General Court of this Province have voted that a Bounty or Incouragement be grated and allowed to be paid out of the Publick Treasury, to the marching Forces that shall have been employed for the Defence of the *Eastern* and *Western* Frontiers, from the *First* to the *Twenty-fifth* of this Instant *November*;

I have thought fit to publish the same; and I do hereby promise, That there shall be paid out of the

Province=Treasury to all and any of the laid forces, over and above their Bounty upon Fulfillment, their Wages and Subsistence, the Premiums or Bounty following, ^{viz.}

For every Male *Penobscot* Indian above the Age of Twelve Years, that shall be taken within the Time aforesaid and brought to *Boston*, *Fifty Pounds*.

For every Scalp of a Male *Penobscot* Indian above the Age aforesaid, brought in as Evidence of their being killed as aforesaid, *Forty Pounds*.

For every Female *Penobscot* Indian taken and brought in as aforesaid, and for every Male Indian Prisoner under the Age of Twelve Years, taken and brought in as aforesaid, *Twenty-five Pounds*.

For every Scalp of such Female Indian or Male Indian under the Age of Twelve Years, that shall be killed and brought in as Evidence of their being killed as aforesaid, *Twenty Pounds*.

Given at the Council-Chamber in Boston, this Third Day of November 1755, and in the Twenty-ninth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord GEORGE the Second, by the Grace of GOD of Great-Britain, France and Ireland, KING, Defender of the Faith, etc
